Wood Badge is open to any registered Scouter. Scouters should be trained in their respective position. The first portion of the course uses a classroom approach with practical exercises to teach the essentials of leadership. You will learn what makes leadership work for you in Scouting and in your personal life.

The second half of the course offers classroom and outdoor experiences to help you learn the application of the leadership skills. There will also be a group meeting or two that you will need to attend in between weekends. Your group will set that schedule. You will also write and complete a "Ticket". Successful completion of the course will be your attendance at both weekends, in their entirety, as well as the completion of the Ticket process.

Our staff is committed to helping you succeed! We will provide you the necessary guidance and encouragement to complete the course and your Ticket. Upon completion of the course, you will be assigned a Ticket counselor for continued guidance and support. Upon completion of your Ticket, you will receive the Wood Badge Recognition, including the neckerchief, woggle, Wood Badge beads and Certificate of completion.

What do you need? A BSA physical, personal camping equipment, trained in your Scouting position, a desire to learn, an ability to have fun, and a commitment to apply what you learn
